As you mentioned this is on BOO model Bidder is responsible to run the complete solution. We request you to kindly remove this point because it is restricting the fair or open competition in tender. RD certification shall be on SI's name/OEM/ any consortium partners should be considered	RD certification shall be in name of SI / OEM / any consortium partner. SI shall be solely responsible for provision, continuity and registration of RD Services with UIDAI Also, disruption in RD services will be considered as service disruption and clause u/s 6.2 of RFP will be applicable.

While the procurement of antenna depending on the requirement of the State, which will be used in remote locations and hilly areas for better signal, reception and seamless transactions.	All the smart POS devices like have inbuilt antenna and if signals are less then it works with boosters which gets connected over Wifi. Now no manufacturer built any slot or port for external antenna at all. If required to boost the signals in some hilly or very less signal area then boosters are available to do the needful. These boosters work over wifi signals and interact with Mobile towers over GSM cloud. We request you to kindly consider that device should have provision to connect with external antenna or signal booster.	The Device should have provision to connect with external antenna or any other legitimate mode to overcome the problem of low signals and ensuring uninterrupted transactions in low signal areas. The cost to ensure legitimate solution & cost of any such means / modes supplied by SI should be borne by SI only. SI has to specifically mention the details of such component in post-delivery inspection report as mentioned in point 20 of section 5.1 of RFP. SI is solely responsible for service availability under low signals. Also, this disruption will be considered as service disruption and clause u/s 6.2 of RFP will be applicable.
